THEME	PROBLEMS	SOLUTIONS
Travel time (and delays)	 Delays and missed transfers Large lag time between connections Long travel time from Central Valley to SF or LA, not worth taking train 	 Improve shuttle or bus connections from last train stations to reach destination – preferably EV and airconditioned
Service frequency	 Students have odd hours - need trains early morning and late night People are often stranded due to infrequency of service 	 Have more frequent trains with fewer stops – consider 24/7 trains given soaring gas prices Have earlier morning and later evening trains
Parking	 Parking sold out on busy weekends Expensive parking Safety concerns in parking lots 	 Provide additional parking on special events days Provide incentive for single car commuters to switch to passenger rail (example: discounts for parking for valley people who commute more than 50 miles) Add cameras and better lighting in parking lots
Information and accessibility	Confusing for new passengers, lack of informationBroken elevators	 Improve real-time online information using apps and websites – with options for "fast", "safe" and "disability" route navigation







	 Disabled people having to rush to catch the trains from station to station Hard to climb up to upper level of train (Amtrak) 	 Keep elevators in working condition for wheelchair users Widen stairways on trains Develop a universal card for all transportation - Amtrak, ACE, BART, CC, public bus
Parking lot/out of scope	 Incentives: Low awareness and usage of passenger rail Cost: Using own vehicle is cheaper for some distances, train can be more expensive Safety: In parking lots and on tracks, on trains late at night, luggage storage and safety from theft
