Service frequency	 The train schedule and my schedule do not align and that's why I don't want to use rail 	 Have more trains on each route
Station location/access to stations	No good connections from one route to the nextNo stations close by	Build more stationsDevelop better bicycle routes to get to train stations
Information and accessibility	 There are no maps to let people know which train to take when they want to get to a destination People do not speak English and difficult to navigate trains Older adults have difficulty understanding how to use the train system 	 Signs that let people know train numbers and routes Provide information in multiple languages and have an app like Google Maps. Have organization like HYPU teach older adults so they will know how to use trains Have schools take youth on trains to learn how to use trains Provide Hmong recording when they purchase train tickets and when they have questions Provide information about destinations in Hmong







Access to destinations	 No direct route to the airport No route to places that people want to go 	 Have direct routes to certain destinations like airport Have routes that will take people to places they want to go
Parking lot/out of scope	 Cost: Fare prices for seniors and youth are too high, fares may not be comparable or more expensive than Lyft/Uber Safety: stations are not well-lit; unhoused people on trains and at stations Lack of cleanliness and amenities: no food on trains for long trips, lack of available restrooms High volume of passengers: too many people ride Amtrak, afraid of strangers 	 Provide free tickets for older adults and students Have lights so people will feel safe Provide sanitation tables and hand sanitizers at train stations and on the trains for people to use
